Despite a challenging year for all, our

volunteers worked on 2 paths in 2020. At 182 steps, Lower Columbia Path is one of our longest path to date. It connects Queens Road and Fairlawn Drive in the Terrace View neighborhood and was completed in April 2020. Handrails were added in July 2020. Work is almost complete on Lower Halkin Walk as well, a 145-step path in the hills north of Marin Avenue. Lower Halkin is a "missing link" path, completing a pedestrian corridor from Grizzly Peak Boulevard to Spruce Street. If you're enjoying walking the paths, please consider supporting our work so we can keep building paths like Columbia and Halkin. All your #givingtuesday donations will go to a handrail fund for Lower Halkin Walk.



This fun, free Zoom tour, sponsored by Greenbelt Alliance and led by Bob Johnson, features 7 rock parks centered on large volcanic rock outcroppings (shown, Contra Costa Rock Park). Bob leads us along delightful pedestrian paths and stairways to enjoy fine vistas and quintessential North Berkeley neighborhoods, with lovely gardens and architecture. The actual walk is 5 miles roundtrip with 1,100 feet of elevation gain, but Bob covers it all in 1 hour in this virtual tour. 
